

Latest version of SOUL 3.0 software was installed to assist faculty members and students. Also, British council and NSDL membership has been subscribed for library to access online reading material / resources.


LMS: (Learning Management system)

Internal Quality Assurance Cell in an institution is a significant administrative body that is that is responsible for all quality matters. IQAC is a major step in pushing long term quality standards. It is the prime responsibility of IQAC to initiate plan and supervise various activities that are necessary to increase the quality of the education. We are committed to provide quality education in all three streams running in the college i.e. Arts, Science and Commerce (vocational).

Teaching learning plans-The teaching faculty prepared their Teaching learning plans as per the work load.

Remedial lectures -Online Remedial lectures for the students who need extra support have been conducted.

Advance learners- Measures were also taken for advanced learner active involvement in presentations and discussions

Innovations in teaching and learning- COVID-19 resulted in shutting of educational institutions across all across the country resulting in drastic shift in ways to impart education. It was a sudden and unprecedented change from the traditional physical classroom teaching to the virtual mode of teaching. There was distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching was undertaken on digital platforms. On-line Classes with the tremendous support of all the professors ensured the smooth conduct of online classes through various digital modes like Google Meet, Zoom from the month of April 2020.

Student Feedback- Formal feedback mechanism is in place at college website. Feedback from final year students and their parents on various parameters like teaching, infrastructure, and facilities has been taken for further improvements.

Research- Out of 11 teaching faculty four are Ph.D and 4 are pursuing research. The staff constantly makes efforts to write research papers in their respective fields and get them published in reputed journal. Moreover, the faculty has participated in various workshops, conferences, FDPs, webinars, etc. during the year.

Institution has various committee for transparency, timely redressal of student grievances, Maintenance of ragging free campus, prevention of sexual harassment during the year.

IQAC has organized several sessions to foster physical as well as mental wellbeing of students during covid times. Mentioned below are some of the initiatives of IQAC for academic session 2020-21.


